Department Introduction:

- The Department of Hadith and Its Sciences is one of the academic departments in the College of Islamic Sciences" at the University of Fallujah. It was established in the academic year "2017-2018" to meet the scientific needs for this important specialization, particularly for students of Islamic studies and generally for students of educational schools.

- The department aims to prepare students who are scientifically proficient in the sciences of the Sunnah, aware of the conspiracies and smear campaigns against the Prophetic Sunnah, and capable of responding to these suspicions on solid scientific grounds.
- The department is considered one of the important pillars of the college because its specialization is related to the "second source of Islamic legislation".
- It interacts with all scientific and linguistic specializations available in the college.

- The department seeks to develop its staff, support the educational process, and enhance the skills of graduate students.
- The department constantly strives to achieve quality standards and obtain program accreditation.
